

## PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Winona, Minnesota, USA, and Bytow, Poland

**WHEREAS**, the Sister City Program, administered by Sister Cities International, was initiated by the President of the United States of America in 1956 to encourage greater friendship and understanding between the United States and other nations through direct personal contact, and

**WHEREAS**, in order to foster those goals, the people of Winona, Minnesota, and Bytow, Poland, in a gesture of friendship and goodwill, agree to collaborate for the mutual benefit of their communities by exploring educational, economic, and cultural opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, we agree to support and encourage opportunities for mutually beneficial practical exchanges in the fields of business, education, health, science, tourism, arts and culture.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Winona, Minnesota, and Bytow, Poland, do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities, and declare their intent to abide by these guidelines according to Sister Cities International policies.


This document goes into effect on November 8, 2004, and is written in both English and Polish.
